

Position: Conservation Agent

Salary Range: \$25.36 to 31.93/hr. Part time up to 25 hours.

Town of Randolph is seeking a Conservation Officer to provide coordination, support and professional management to the Conservation Commission in carrying out its important mission to protect the community's natural resources including education in and enforcement of the Wetlands Protection Act and local watershed and wetlands bylaws. Duties include enforcement functions to support the laws and bylaws designed to conserve land and natural resources, acting as liaison with regulatory agencies, conducting inspections and investigations, and performing a variety of administrative duties.

Qualifications: A candidate for this position should have a BS in landscape architecture, biology, hydrogeology, or similar field and three to five years dealing with conservation issues, design professionals, state and federal agencies, and wetland regulations or equivalent education and experience. He/she should have knowledge of, but not limited to, the state rivers acts, state wetlands protection act, stewardship of open space, wetland delineation, and land management principles and practices. The ability to interact effectively with the public and town boards, explain and interpret conservation laws and codes to the public and enforce such laws and codes will be critical for the successful candidate.
