Your Key Responsibilities

- Responsible for using a Trimble mapping-grade GPS and other GPS enabled devices to guide and collect field data for field teams on both large and small scale wetland delineations, natural resource mapping, vernal pool assessments, rare threatened and endangered species surveys, and other natural community assessments.
- Candidates should expect to spend the majority of their time at remote locations in the field and be willing to travel 1-2 weeks at a time throughout New England and beyond.
- Working long hours, outside, in variable weather conditions, over rough terrain is typical for this position.
- Technicians will be assigned a GPS enabled device and will be responsible for following the established GPS standard operating procedures.

- A basic knowledge of natural communities, wetlands, plants, and/or soils
- Experience in writing articles or reports that focus on applied field biology
