Paperless Option Q&A

A PAPERLESS OPTION in the S.A.M. has been introduced for those who prefer the electronic version of M-U-M rather than receiving the printed edition in the mail.

Who is eligible for PAPERLESS OPTION?

Anyone qualified for Assembly, Associate or Junior Assembly membership in the S.A.M. may select the PAPERLESS OPTION.

How much are PAPERLESS OPTION dues?

Since no postage is necessary to send out magazines, PAPERLESS OPTION members will pay \$45 annually. No postage surcharge is required for non-U.S. members.

What benefits does the PAPERLESS OPTION provide?

PAPERLESS OPTION members receive the same benefits as any Assembly, Associate or Junior Member except that the M-U-M magazine is not mailed to them; but is available only online.

How do I access M-U-M Online?

The online edition of M-U-M is located in the "members only" section of the S.A.M. website: www.magicsam.com. To access, you will need your S.A.M. membership number.

As an S.A.M. member – can I convert my membership to the PAPERLESS OPTION?

Upon the renewal of your membership, you can opt for the PAPERLESS OPTION.

What if I want a printed single copy?

Printed copies will be available from the National Administrator for a nominal charge.

I don't want to go PAPERLESS. Can I still read M.U.M. Online?

Yes, all members can read M.U.M. Online in the member's only section of the S.A.M. website: www.magicsam.com. To access the members only section, you will need your S.A.M. membership number.

I'm a life member. Can I take the PAPERLESS OPTION?

Yes. You can notify our National Administrator that you wish to go PAPERLESS and she will switch you over.

Please read the following carefully to help you complete the application for membership. Complete the application fully.

A. Eligibility:

- **1. Assembly Membership:** Any reputable person 18 years of age or older, sincerely interested in magic as an art, is eligible for Assembly Membership provided the individual agrees to join an active Assembly. Two Assembly sponsors are required.
- **2. Junior Assembly Membership:** Any reputable person 14 years of age or older, genuinely interested in Magic as an Art and sponsored by two Assembly Members, is eligible for Junior Assembly Membership. That person will remain under the sponsorship of the Members endorsing the application until the individual assumes regular Membership at age 18.
- **3. Associate Membership:** Any reputable person 14 years of age or older, genuinely interested in Magic as an Art, and agreeable to a *bona fide* endeavor to affiliate with an Assembly is eligible for Associate Membership. No sponsors are required, but applicants are carefully screened by the National Committee on Admissions.
- **4. Paperless Option:** This option includes all of the benefits of any of the above memberships. This member will NOT receive a printed copy of MUM in the mail. They will have access to the MUM magazine Online, which is the full magazine in a multimedia edition, and includes video clips and advertiser's links.
- **5. Household Membership:** Any reputable person 14 years of age or older, sincerely interested in Magic as an Art, *residing at the same address as another member*. Household members do not receive the M-U-M magazine or have access to it online. Note: An applicant may not elect to apply for household unless the Member in Good Standing is in the same household.
- **6. Young Membership:** Applicants for Young Membership are requested to ask for and submit a Young Member's application. Any reputable person 7-17 years of age, sincerely interested in the Art of Magic, is eligible for membership in the Society of Young Magicians. S.Y.M. Members have full access to the website www.magicsam.com to be able to read the newsletter written especially for youth "Magic SYMbol Online" and access to the M-U-M.

B. Definitions:

- **1. Professional:** At least 50% of the individual's livelihood is earned though the practice of magic.

- **3. Amateur:** One who is interested in the Art of Magic and who receives no compensation for the practice of this Art.
- **4. Assistant:** An individual who helps any of the above in their presentation of the Art of Magic.
