Sheriff's Civil Service (Updated)

- Harry McKenney, Chief Civil Sheriff for Kennebec County, conducted survey of all counties and received the following:
 - Aroostook: child protective only
 - Androscoggin: limited; you plead case and they decide
 - **Cumberland: full service**
 - **Franklin: full service**
 - Hancock: no service
 - **Kennebec: full service**
 - Knox: criminal hearing subpoenas only
 - Lincoln: no service
 - Oxford: judge ordered only
 - Penobscot: limited; orders or hearing notices only
 - Piscataquis: court issued only
 - Sagadahoc: sends paperwork to deputy and lets deputy decide whether to serve
 - Somerset: civil service suspended until further notice
 - Waldo: on hold
 - Washington: on hold
 - York: unable to reach
