Courthouse Access During the Pandemic Health Emergency

Your case has been set for hearing as shown on the attached notice or order.

Please review the following questions:

1. In the last seven days, have you experienced any acute respiratory illness symptoms (i.e., cough, shortness of breath, sore throat), flu-like symptoms, had a fever, coughing, sneezing, or other flu like symptoms?
2. Do you live with, or have you been in close (less than 6 feet) prolonged contact, (more than 30 minutes) with someone who has or had a diagnosis of COVID-19?
3. Do you live with, or have you been in close (less than 6 feet) prolonged contact, (more than 30 minutes) with someone who has or had fever, cough, shortness of breath, or flu-like symptoms?
4. Within the last 14 days, have you traveled outside of Maine or have you had close contact with someone who has traveled outside of Maine?
5. Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been asked to self-quarantine by any hospital, health agency, nurse practitioner, physician's assistant, or doctor?
