**STEVENS RECEIVES  
OUTSTANDING FAMILY PHYSICIAN OF THE YEAR AWARD FROM  
MICHIGAN ASSOCIATION OF OSTEOPATHIC FAMILY PHYSICIANS**

Stevens, D.O., formerly of Rockford, Michigan, now residing in Beaver Dam, Wisconsin, was awarded the 2013 Outstanding Family Physician of the Year Award by the Michigan Association of Osteopathic Family Physicians (MAOFP) at the annual MAOFP Summer Family Medicine Update on August 2, 2013.
