THE PROCEDURES FOR DEALING WITH FIRES IN THE WORKPLACE

How to contain & extinguish fires and hand over the fire site to the appropriate personnel. Reporting on fire and fire equipment.

THE TYPES OF FIRES AND THE APPROPRIATE FIRE FIGHTING PROCEDURE

Materials that cause fires such as flammable liquids and gases, live electrical equipment, and combustible metals. Considering the adjacent hazards and the methods of fire transmission include conduction, induction, radiation.

HOW TO IDENTIFY & SELECT APPROPRIATE FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT

How to identifying Firefighting equipment such as hoses, extinguishers and buckets and their appropriate use.

FIGHT CONTAINABLE/EXTINGUISHABLE FIRES

How to establish and respond to the status of a fire and the changes in the fire including changes in wind direction, backdraft, ventilation, release of hazardous substances, radiation, or because of incorrect application of firefighting procedures.

FIRE HAND OVER

How to safely retreat from fire site and hand over to appropriate personnel.
