CONDUCT CONTINUOUS RISK ASSESSMENT

The purpose of this course is to be able to explain the legal and specified requirements for conducting continuous risk assessments, prepare to and conduct a continuous risk assessment and initiate remedial follow up action.

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CONDUCTING CONTINUOUS RISK ASSESSMENTS

The process and required documentation to conduct a continuous risk assessment. How to identifying the relevant hazards and risks likely to be encountered during a specific continuous risk assessment, and how to conduct continuous risk assessment in a manner that fosters teamwork and avoids conflict.

HOW TO PREPARE TO CONDUCT A CONTINUOUS RISK ASSESSMENT

Evaluating the various physical and environmental conditions which could exist, and selecting the appropriate documentation, people, tools, and the materials required to conduct the continuous risk assessment while understanding the consequences for not conforming to legal requirements.

HOW TO CONDUCT A CONTINUOUS RISK ASSESSMENT

Correctly identifying the hazards systematically utilising the elected hazard identification technique, and then complete the relevant documentation.

HOW TO INITIATE REMEDIAL ACTION AND FOLLOW UP ON CONTINUOUS RISK ASSESSMENT

How to implement remedial and follow up action for the identified hazards. How to explain to staff the consequences of non-compliance to the procedures for initiating remedial and follow-up action.



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
