This course ensures that workers and public are safe, when work has to be done on or next to a road in an urban area, and learners will be able to select and set up temporary road signs and barriers at road works to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists and workers, when any work has to be done in a road or next to a road on the pavement

PLAN THE WORK TASK

How to interpret job instructions and determine a sequence of operation using the correct temporary road signs and equipment to meet the requirements of the job. Understanding that equipment needs to be inspected for high visibility and any defects need to be reported to the supervisor. The road traffic act needs to be followed when loading equipment onto a vehicle.

SAFE LOADING AND OFFLOADING OF EQUIPMENT

How to check a vehicle and ensure that equipment is suitably placed and secured onto the vehicle. The road traffic act needs to be followed when transporting workers, and the vehicle needs to be correctly placed for the safe offloading of equipment and workers.

SET-UP TEMPORARY ROAD SIGNS

How to ensure that temporary signs and equipment are placed at the correct intervals, clearly visible and in the correct sequence according to the road traffic act. That the workplace is demarcated to ensure the safety of the worker as well as the public and that the correct flagging signals are used to control the traffic

COMPLETION OF THE TASK

How to ensure that temporary signs and equipment are correctly off loaded, cleaned, stored and any damaged equipment is reported. Work area is restored to a serviceable condition for the safety of pedestrians and motorists.



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
