The purpose of this course is to provide the necessary knowledge related to safety in a work area, specifically looking at being able to identify potential hazards in the work area, limit damage to persons or property in the case of an emergency and follow procedures that apply to illness or injury in the work area.

HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

- How to identify potential hazards and know how to correctly remove, reduce or report on those potential hazards.
- Having and understanding of hazardous substances and the implications of exposure to hazardous substances.
- How to draw up a health and safety plan.
- How to use and identify Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and other clothing requirements.
- How to ensure that all statutory requirements are being met.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

- Identifying the location of fire extinguishers, hoses, and alarms.
- Identifying and correctly using different fire extinguishers.
- Understanding the procedures for the identification of emergencies and how to follow them promptly and correctly.
- Understanding the procedures for reporting and recording incidents.
- Understanding the procedures to be followed if an injury may lead to a claim against workman's compensation.
- How to write a brief incident report and deliver it to the relevant authority.



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
