Identify hazards relative to gasses, water, fire, soil types and conditions, installation processes of material and plant and the operation of plant and equipment

IDENTIFY APPROPRIATE PROTECTIVE CLOTHING OR EQUIPMENT

How to identify the relevant Protective clothing or equipment required for the various types of hazards encountered in confined spaces, and how to use it correctly.

IDENTIFY TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR UNSKILLED WORKERS WORKING IN CONFINED SPACES & TRAIN THE WORKERS.

Develop training programmes to sensitize unskilled workers to the dangers of working in confined spaces and how to prepare to secure confined spaces and perform necessary actions in confined spaces.

PLAN AND IMPLEMENT EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Preparing a plan of action for emergency, how to implement the plan and identify resources to handle an emergency.

RELEVANT OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

Understanding the Occupational Health and Safety Act (no 85 of 1993) relative to working in confined spaces and the requirements in terms of safety compliance.
