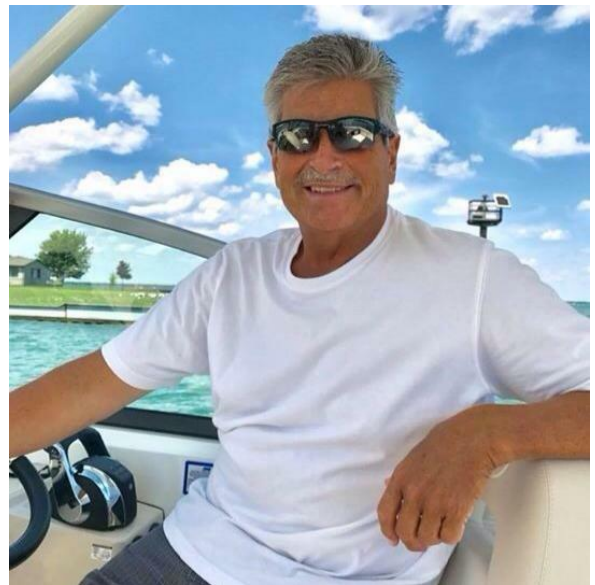


The Recreational Boating Industries Educational Foundation
