**Minimum Requirements for State Representatives
February 16, 2009**

On December 23rd, 2008, the DRI Governance Committee met by conference call and unanimously voted to recommend that the DRI Board of Directors establish minimum requirements for State Representatives, and further that the DRI bylaws be amended accordingly. The Governance Committee recommends the following qualification.

- A. State Representatives must be Individual Members of the Corporation admitted to practice of law in the state he or she will represent,
- B. The State Representative candidate shall have been a DRI member for a total of at least three (3) years,
- C. The State Representative candidate shall have been a member of at least one (1) DRI substantive law committee for at least three (3) years,
- D. The State Representative candidate must have registered for and attended at least one (1) DRI Annual Meeting within the previous three (3) years,
- E. Prior to serving as a State Representative, the candidate must have registered for and attended at least one (1) DRI seminar or registered for and attended at least one (1) DRI Regional Meeting.

The DRI Board of Directors may vote to waive a portion of these requirements upon showing of good cause.

These requirements will take effect October 24th, 2010
