**AMENDED CASE MANAGEMENT  
ORDER**

WHEREAS, broad authority has been granted to the Minnesota Asbestos Litigation docket judges by the Minnesota Supreme Court and Chief Judge of Ramsey County District Court; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of asbestos litigation parties and the Court to promote the expeditious and efficient handling of litigation involving asbestos products; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the administration of justice requires that asbestos product liability litigation be coordinated and made uniform to the fullest extent possible; and,

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the above goals, this Court issued its Minnesota Asbestos Litigation Case Management Order on November 25, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Minnesota Asbestos Litigation Case Management Order in light of the July 1, 2013 amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure:

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

This Court's Minnesota Asbestos Litigation Case Management Order dated November 25, 2008, shall remain in full force and effect, with the exception of Section I, which is amended as set forth below:


**SCOPE AND EFFECT**

Unless they conflict with this Order, all actions within the scope of this Order are governed by the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure, the Minnesota General Rules of Practice for the District Courts, and all other applicable rules. However, the following 2013 amendments to Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure shall not apply to actions governed by this Order: Rules 26.01, 26.02(e), 37.01, 37.03, and 37.06. Instead, the pre-July 1, 2013 version of Minn. R. Civ. P. 26.01, 26.02(e), 37.01, 37.03, and 37.06 shall control cases governed by this Order.
