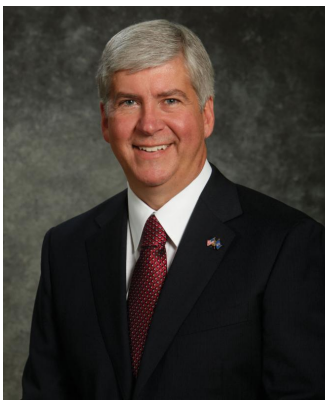

House Bill 4472

Critical legislation creates a pathway for the substitution of interchangeable biologic medicines, with appropriate communication to patients and physicians.
