2026 Winter Conference Update

Executive Director Wiles reported that the 2026 Winter Conference is the MACP's largest conference to date. All 171 exhibitor spots have been sold out, with an additional 32 companies currently on the waiting list.

There are 426 attendees registered for the conference.

The event has secured three Diamond Sponsors, MMRMA, Iron Bow, and Peregrine, and \$94,600 has been collected in total sponsorship revenue to date.

Future Training Update

The Spring 2026 New Chiefs' School will be held May 4-8, 2026 at the Okemos Conference Center and registration will open next week after we return from the conference. It is expecting to fill quickly.

The Fall 2026 New Chiefs' School is scheduled for September 14-18, 2026 at the Okemos Conference Center. Registration will open after the Spring NCS session is completed.

The 3rd Annual Administrative Assistants Conference will be held April 23-24, 2026 at the Courtyard by Marriott in Mt. Pleasant. This event will be opened up for registration next week.

The Summer Conference will be held June 21-24, 2026 at Shanty Creek resort and registration will open in the next few weeks.

The MACP will hold another *Knowledge at Noon* on February 17th on Election Preparation and Resources for Law Enforcement, presented by the Michigan Department of State (MDOS): Bureau of Elections, and Michigan Attorney General's (AG) Office, Criminal Division, in partnership with the Michigan Department of State Office of Investigative Services.

Chief Kirk reviewed the bills that were considered by the Committee at their last meeting and provided some updates. Fourteen of the bills involved drones and a lot of good feedback was provided. There is a lot of work to be done on these bills, and the Committee is attempting to create a clear list of the law enforcement concerns to take to the committee chair, Representative William Bruck.

MCOLLES Report – Exec. Director Tim Bourgeois

MCOLLES is currently working on revisions to the Subject Control Curriculum. He noted that there are some significant changes to be made on the training program. If the Commission approves, he will let everyone know.
