# 2018 State Legislation

---

- AB 375 (passed) – California version of the EU GDPR
- AB 2225 (3<sup>rd</sup> reading) – Security Guidelines / Standards for storing public records (for cloud vendors)
- AB 1906 & SB 327 (suspense) – Internet Connected Device security
- AB 2813 (suspense) – OES Cyber Integration Center to create incident response team

# 2018 State Legislation cont.

- AB 1859 (suspense) – Credit Agencies must protect PII – residents can sue for damages
- SB 532 (inactive) – Adding Cyberterrorism to emergency list
- Trend - Bills to protect Election Data

# Federal Legislation

---

- Shift in recent years from corporate scams and data theft to foreign hackers and large scale government infrastructure breaches
- EO 13800 – Strengthening the Cybersecurity of Federal Networks and Critical Infrastructure
- S. 2639 (introduced in April) – US version of the EU GDPR

# Other Federal Legislation

---

- S. 3157 – Okay so its not a Cyber Bill....  
But you need to oppose this one!
- US Version of SB 649
- Carriers gain control of public assets, processes and fees regarding small cell implementations
