The ideal **Survey I** candidate will have either a Bachelor's degree in Land Surveying with 4 years of experience or have 10 years of field experience in the Land Surveying field. Interested candidates must be proficient in use of total stations and GPS equipment to perform topographical surveys and construction layout, and must have the ability to communicate effectively with management, department heads, staff personnel, and the general public. A working knowledge of CADD drafting system and roadway design would be beneficial.
