

**Jon Eaton Excellence in Volunteering Award
Minnesota Section
AWWA**

Purpose of the Award: The purpose of the Jon Eaton Excellence in Volunteering award is to honor a Volunteer Leader whose dedicated leadership has led to significant achievements through volunteer activities within Minnesota Section AWWA. *This award is given to someone that has served in a leadership role of a volunteer program that has benefitted AWWA.*

The Award: A plaque/trophy.

Frequency of the Award: Annually presented at the Minnesota Section Annual Conference or as deserved

Eligibility for this Award: AWWA membership and outstanding service to the Minnesota Section. Persons who have received the Volunteer of the Year or the Jon Eaton Excellence in Volunteering Award previously are not eligible. Members of the current MN AWWA Board of Directors are not eligible.

Entry Requirements: Any member may nominate one individual for this award and should submit to the Secretary a completed entry form including biographical information outlining his/her significant contributions. Entry forms are available at the MN AWWA web site.

Nominating Procedures: The Jon Eaton Excellence in Volunteering Award Committee shall select by ballot the most deserving member who has rendered outstanding service to the Section.

Nomination or Submission Deadline: July 1

Method of Selecting Award Recipient: The Volunteer of the Year Award Committee shall select a recipient from the list of nominees by a simple vote.

Presentation of the Award: The award will be presented at the Appreciation Night event of the Minnesota Section Annual Conference
