Summer Conference 2003 will be held June 17th thru June 20th, in Winona at the Best Western Riverport Inn & Suites.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business.

NEW BUSINESS

Suspect document forms were passed out and we are to make copies of them. Any suspicious transactions, and we are to fill them in and attach any documents in question, then send them on to the United States Secret Service Office in Minneapolis.

Bev Bauer and the By-law committee have been working on an issue in the by-laws of adding a 3rd Vice President to the slate of officers for the Recorder's Association. It was brought up that adding a 3rd vice would create more expenses such as meals mileage and lodging. Gail brought up the fact that with e-mails, and only a Spring and Fall board meeting, that the expenses would be minimal. By adding a 3rd Vice President, it gives another year to learn exactly what is expected and how to go about carrying out the duties of the position of President. Allen made a motion and Andrea seconded it, to add a 3rd Vice President to the slate of Officers.

Nominations

A motion was made by Jeff and seconded by Carmen to accept the slate of candidates as recommended. Cindy then swore all the newly elected officers in.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Legislation

Jeff and Larry presented the Recorder's platform for the legislative session for this year. They stated that there wouldn't be much worked on this year with the budget shortfall, and it being a short session. The ERER surcharge for Torrens, would be addressed and the Bar Association was still looking into language with doing away with Affidavits of Purchasers. Discharges were still being talked about, but would probably not be brought up this year.

Torrens

A Torrens workshop was held at the Elk River Government Center last fall and was well attended. Redoing the Torrens manual had been discussed by the committee as it has been a few years since it has been done, and there have been many changes. Eliminating the Affidavit of Purchaser form had been discussed at length. The language for the .50 ERER Surcharge for Torrens documents is ready for the 2002 legislative session. A motion was made and seconded to have the language in the bill to read that the surcharge would become effective as soon as it is passed and signed by the Governor or 10 days after the Governor has signed it.

Committee of the Future

Jeanine stated that they hadn't been very active. Some things for future discussion

- are: 1. What could the Recorders do for increased revenue resources?, like raising dues. Having dues broke out by county size.
 - 2. Vendor fees-Summer Conference
 - 3. Charge more for training sessions
 - 4. Cut down on expenses by telephone conference calls, limit number of people on a committee.
 - 5. Establish uniform county user fees
 - Regular newsletters informing everyone what each county is doing or have a couple-three counties each time.

Education & Certification

Bonnie informed the group that MACO would be sending out Certificates for those who had 45 or more credited hours completed. There would be a press release sent out for the recorder to place in their local paper, and radio station. There would be a newly elected recorder's session again next winter. Everyone was to make sure that all of their credited hour sheets had been sent in.

Vitals

Cheryl stated that there would be no handbooks for the VRV2000. We are to go to the MN Dept of Health web site and print out the rules. Funeral home would be having training sessions in March. Delayed and Historical births are to be done as before. We can not charge a data entering fee to funeral directors. There can be no white out used on the original death form submitted by the funeral directors.

UCC

Kay stated no new problems, just same old frustrations. Just continue on, it will get better.

MRESA

Cathy is still attending meetings and the minutes are going out with the Monday updates. The meetings are still informative.

HISTORIAN

Loretta just took over at summer conference so working on project for summer

Gail passed the gavel to our new president, Ken Schmalz. Ken then presented Gail with a plaque honoring her past year as president.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting.
