E-BOARD MEETING—JUNE 3, 2003

Kay called the meeting to order at 1:15 PM.

those in attendance were: Kay Wrucke, Sue Alberts, Jeanine Barker, Bunny Johnston, Larry Dalien, Jeff Aitken and Kathy Conlon.

The first item of business was to go over the 2003 budget and to go over deposits and expenditures for the Summer workshop and conference. As of June 6th, 2003, the balance is #31,868.28. We received \$8,700 from our share of the Winter conference; \$2,100.00 from the New Recorder's workshop held in Elk River; and \$15,729.68 from the summer registrations so far for summer workshop and conference. The monies received from the New Recorder's workshop was basically a wash covering materials, speakers, etc. There have been 53 registered for the summer workshop so far, with several affirming but not paying yet. We have received \$2,335.45 from vendors. Others have stated they are going, but haven't sent in their fees as yet. Kay then went over the projected expenditures for the workshop.

When going over the agenda, we decided that some of the important topics were: new legislation effective this year along with the legislations that is being looked at for 2004 session. New legislation and a fee increase for marriage applications. Some of the language in the statutes is still not correct, and we should be getting more for processing them. There is going to be a discussion on increasing fees to our offices instead of always increasing fees to the state, along with a discussion on adding a fee for doing splits. Some counties have already started this and some are already charging a processing fee for walking and rejecting documents. Minnesota Department of Health, well division, is talking about including septic language with the well certificate and increasing the fee. We need a person sitting in on that discussion at the state level. There is going to be a tangible interest form like the birth and death form, but it hasn't been developed yet or we haven't seen one.

Kay stated that Luci's contract would be up July 1, and if there were any issues to let her know at conference. She would relay them to the rest of the Maco Board.

Bunny volunteered to do the tickets would be arriving Monday night so she could start stuffing packets.

Meeting adjourned at 3; 30.
