Committee Reports – August 2014

Awards (Mark Kotz & Ben Verbick)

Communications & Outreach (Ben Verbick)

• Did not meet this month, nothing new to report.

Conference (Kitty Hurley & Geoff Maas)

1. Keynote Speakers: *Thursday* – Kevin Mickey; *Friday* – Joshua Stevens.

2. Food:

- Sponsored hot breakfast Thursday morning provided by Pro West & Associates.
- Lunch: *Thursday* Pork; *Friday* Breakfast for lunch.
- Additional options added to the vendor reception Thursday evening.

3. Program:

- Preliminary Program available on the registration and conference website pages.
- Final Program wording needed by August 29th.
- 4. General Registration: Available to all attendees through all payment options.
- **5. Salary Survey:** Presenting on Friday before the membership (*additional discussion in a separate board agenda topic*).

6. Student Assistantship Program:

- There were 4 applicants from different institutions, all of which were accepted by the Conference Chairs.
- All students will receive complimentary registration and a shared hotel room in exchange for their assistance at the conference.
- The students will be sponsored in full by WSB & Associates.

7. Workshops:

- There are 15 workshops with a wide range of topics and skill levels.
- The committee has created a Google Docs document for student moderators.
- **8. Sessions:** There are 37 confirmed sessions with 86 accepted abstracts by the committee and presenters.

9. Facilities:

- On-Site Signage:
 - Signage has been specifically designed for sessions.
 - Specialized signage has been designed for K-12 teachers, the Thursday K-12 session and directing the teachers to the vendor reception.
 - All signage will include social media information including hashtags.
- *Exhibitor Booths:* Booths are being assigned based on registration date and vendor requests. The MN GIS/LIS booth will have two tables to accommodate the teachers and give us more room than at previous conferences.

10. Technology:

- *Web Maps:* There are 7 confirmed web maps.
- *Geolounge:* Relocated the Geolounge to the Ballroom, a room that is double in size to last year's location.
- *Vendor Demonstration Area:* A sign-up sheet will be available on-site to vendors for their use to demonstrate software, tools, maps, etc. at their discretion.
- *Interactive AGOL/Mobile Map:* Will be available at the conference, currently researching options to provide an editable service hosted by MN.IT @ DNR staff.

11. Entertainment:

- Wednesday Welcome Networking Event: Rochester Art Center from 6:00 9:00 p.m., Cash Bar, Piano available to all attendees.
- Thursday Evening Tailgate Social Event: Mayo Civic Center Ballroom (using part of the Geolounge, including furniture) from 7:15 11:00 p.m. to showcase the Vikings vs. Packers game on multiple TV screens. Snacks will be available with pizza near halftime. Admission cost: \$10; Admission plus mug cost: \$20. All proceeds will be part of the scholarship fund.
- **12. Awards:** There are 3 nominees 1 lifetime, 2 Polaris recipients (*Their acceptance is pending board approval*).
- **13. User and Regional Groups:** The user and regional group option is included as a text option in registration, as opposed to having conference committee members contact registrants directly. The user and regional group information will be included in the final program.
- **14. Posters:** There are 14 confirmed posters.

- *Mentor Program:* Contacting past mentors and schools that includes information on participation in the program.
- *K-12 Participation:* A panel session is being offered on Thursday afternoon and afterwards will bring in teachers to the vendor reception.

Database & Web (Gerry Sjerven & Bart Richardson)

No Report

Education (Greta Bernatz & Scott Freburg)

- The education committee met for a conference call Wednesday, August 6th from 1pm to 2pm. Kiah Sagami, Brandon Keinath, Scott Freburg, Greta Poser, and Andrew King-Scribbins attended. Brandon Keinath was added to the Education Committee.
- Teacher Training Update There were 325 teachers registered, and just over 200 attended workshops (~65%). There were originally 42 scheduled. 35 were held after some were cancelled due to low enrollment. Participation was lower in the southeast part of the state and higher in the north part of MN. Scott followed up with an email to all registered teachers with the teacher materials and links to additional resources. He copied the education committee and all workshop hosts on this email. There will likely be additional workshops next summer, but the goal will be fewer workshops with higher participant numbers (consolidated locations). There is also consideration of a more intense training opportunity for teachers similar to the 4-day workshop Esri provides.

- Webpage Content The committee is working to update information on the K-12 Links webpage and language for the Educational links landing page.
- GeoFest This is a day-long professional development event for K-12 social studies teachers. It will be held October 11 at Macalester College. Scott requested two booths one for MDE and one for MN GIS/LIS, which was approved. Scott is interested in providing an interactive data collection experience for teachers using the ArcGIS App and ArcGIS Online. It might be nice to have someone else at the booth to help teachers get started and answer questions. Last year at the booth there were lots of questions from teachers about how to get started. This year, there should be more resources for teachers. Those at the GIS/LIS booth last year were making a list of ways the consortium could help teachers. The GeoMentor and getSTEM programs were mentioned as ways GIS professionals can connect with school districts to provide assistance. The GIS/LIS could use our channels to promote these programs.

 - o Poster Competition Submissions are still being accepted.
 - Jobs Panel The panel discussion titled "Finding, Applying for and Interviewing for Jobs in GIS" was assigned to Session 38: Students & Young Professionals on Friday, October 3, 2014 from 10:30 a.m. - 12:00p.m.
 - O Thursday Teacher Session and Event The panel discussion titled "K-12 Educator Presentations and Support" was assigned to Session 18: K-12 Education on Thursday, October 2, 2014 from 3:30 p.m. 5:00 p.m. Scott will be inviting teachers. Geoff has created signage. We ask that part of the MN GIS/LIS booth be used for a place where teachers could follow-up with additional questions during the vendor reception.
 - o Student Assistant Program The committee was updated on the student assistant program.
 - Student Networking at Conference (social media, online map) We continue to work with the conference technology committee to look for ways students can network at the conference using technology. The education committee proposed adding a layer to the conference ArcGIS Online map being developed that would allow students (and perhaps other conference attendees) to add themselves to the map with some information about where they are from, what they do, GIS interests, etc. The technology committee is determining if an editable layer will be possible due to permissions restrictions. There was also a suggestion that there be a time specified for students to meet-up in the GeoLounge. Maybe there could be twitter hashtag for students to use as another way to connect.
 - o Fundraising Ideas The education committee was updated on plans for the Thursday night networking event.

Scholarship (Greta Bernatz)

- Of the all the eligible schools, scholar names have been provided for 13 of 14 spots. The remaining school is still planning to participate and has been notified of upcoming deadlines for submitting information for the conference program.
- Of the 13 selected students, 10 plan to participate in the scholarship competition. One is undecided and has been notified that she will need to decide this week to be included in the conference program.
- Selected students were contacted with information about the scholarship program and asked to provide their biography, project title, and abstract for publishing in the conference program. All necessary information has been received pending one undecided student and the school who has not yet sent their student's name or contact info.
- A request for scholarship competition judges will be made within the week. Former judges will be contacted directly and an e-announcement will be written. Social media might be used as well.
- The scholarship committee is investigating the remaining t-shirt supply and use of funds to order additional t-shirts for fundraising purposes. There is \$400 in the scholarship committee budget for this. Unless otherwise recommended, the t-shirt design would stay the same as last year.
