Requirements:

- **Full time students** enrolled in an accredited college or university;

- **No previous acceptance** in either the Esri Student Assistantship, the Minnesota GIS/LIS Student Assistant Program or any similar program.

What Student Assistants Will Receive:

- Registration to the conference;
- Hotel accommodations;
- A chance to learn more about GIS technology;
- An experienced mentor; and
- The opportunity to network with other students and GIS professionals.

Students are responsible for their own travel and personal expenses.

Follow these steps to submit your application:

Submit a cover letter including:

- Your contact information (phone number and E-mail address);
- What you hope to gain from this experience;
- Your academic interest in GIS; and
- Your experience with GIS.

E-mail your cover letter, resumé and two letters of reference (*preferably one from a professor*) to conference@mngis.org with your e-mail subject as **"MN GIS/LIS Student Assistant Program"**.

Please submit your letters of reference with your cover letter and resumé.
