## Requirements:

- **Full time students** enrolled in an accredited college or university;

- Available to begin work **Wednesday morning (October 28, 2020)** of the conference; and
- **No previous acceptance** in the Minnesota GIS/LIS Student Assistant Program.

## What Student Assistants Will Receive:

- Registration to the conference;
- Hotel accommodations (shared with other assistants);
- A chance to learn more about GIS technology;
- An experienced mentor; and
- The opportunity to network with other students and GIS professionals.

**Students are responsible for their own travel and personal expenses.**

Submit a cover letter including:

- Your contact information (phone number and E-mail address);
- What you hope to gain from this experience;
- Your academic interest in GIS; and
- Your experience with GIS.

Please submit your letters of reference with your cover letter and resume.
