Gibbs is the sponsor of the **NPDES** bill, HR 890 – The REDTAPE Act, with 12 Republican cosponsors. The House passed NPDES legislation, the Reducing Regulatory Burdens Act, in the 115th Congress, but did not see final passage in the Senate.
