

Message from EGLE - Environment, Great Lakes & Energy - State of Michigan

Thank you for reaching out to the campground and public pool program.

Campground and Public Pool owners and operators and the public must adhere to [Executive Order 2020-77](#): Temporary requirement to suspend certain activities that are not necessary to sustain or protect life.

The Order was signed May 7, 2020 and is currently in effect until May 28, 2020 at 11:59 pm.

Your business may also fall under [Executive Order 2020-69](#): Temporary restrictions on the use of places of public accommodation.

This order is currently in effect until May 28 at 11:59 pm.

The reopening of campgrounds for recreational camping and of public pools may be part of a staged approach. This could include new timelines and additional precautions. Keep checking www.michigan.gov/coronavirus and watching the Governor's Press Conferences for up to date information.

We are aware that some licensed facilities are posting anticipated opening dates. These should be tentative and subject to change based on State and local orders in place at that time. Please consult with your Local Health Department or Local Law Enforcement agency on any local orders that may apply to travel, campgrounds, and public pools.

We regret that we do not have more information at this time. EGLE Campground Program will continue to share up-to-date information provided by the Governor's Office, however, we are unable to assist with interpreting Executive Orders.
