HEALTH CENTERS GENERATE SAVINGS



More than **54%** of health center patients are covered by Medicaid but represent **only 1.7%** of the state's total Medicaid expenditures.



The state saves approximately \$2,371 for every Medicaid patient who seeks care from a health center. That's an **estimated savings of more than \$832 million in Michigan.***
