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Outstanding Youth Forestry Achievement Award Guidelines

Award Objectives

1. Recognize and publicize outstanding achievements by Mississippi's youth in the area of forestry and sustainable forest management.
2. Encourage other youth to emulate outstanding performance of award winners.

Nomination Procedures

1. Nomination forms must be complete, accurate, legible, and delivered by the deadline.
2. Nomination package may include up to three letters or documents of support.

Awards

1. This award is presented at the MFA Annual Meeting held each year in October.
2. The award will include a plaque, cash, and a complimentary ticket to the President's Banquet.

Eligibility

1. Youth must be between the ages of 13 and 18 as of January 1 of the award year.
2. Any person or organization is eligible to nominate candidate(s) for this award.

3. Once an individual has won this award, they are not eligible to win again.

Selection Procedure

1. Award winner will be selected by the MFA Youth Forestry Committee.
