NACCED is the only national organization that meets the specific needs of county housing, community development, and economic development agencies. NACCED was created in 1978 after an urban county task force successfully fought to have counties included as Community Development Block Grant entitlements in 1974. Today, NACCED is committed to leading the effort to preserve federal funding for counties and by providing access to federal policy makers, continuing education, and professional networking.

Who are our members?

- NACCED regular membership is open to all county agencies which administer community development, affordable housing, and economic development programs as well as HOME consortia.
- An affiliate membership category is open to all nonprofit organizations, state associations of counties, and city government agencies in the affordable housing, community development, and economic development field.
