On September 19, 2011, Mr. Paul R. Harbison, Jr., the former finance officer for American Legion Post 320, in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, was indicted on three counts of felony embezzlement and one count of converting charitable gaming funds for personal use. The American Legion Post contacted the Spotsylvania Sheriff's Office initially, which in turn contacted the

Office of Charitable Gaming for assistance with the investigation. Mr. Harbison remained at large as of early October. No trial date has been set. ■
