Owned and operated by publishing veteran Lexi Beach, the store boasts a carefully curated inventory catering to the vibrant and diverse communities of Astoria and Long Island City. The Bookshop hosts and sponsors a broad variety of events in the area, including author readings, children's storytime, writing classes, reading series, mindfulness meditation workshops, and open-mic storytelling. We hold memberships in the ABA and NAIBA, and report sales to the New York Times. Bookscan, and the Indie best sellers list.

- The store is a mere **4 subway stops from Manhattan** (approx. 10 minutes), ½ block from the Broadway N/Q station, and a 15-minute walk from the M/R at Steinway.
