

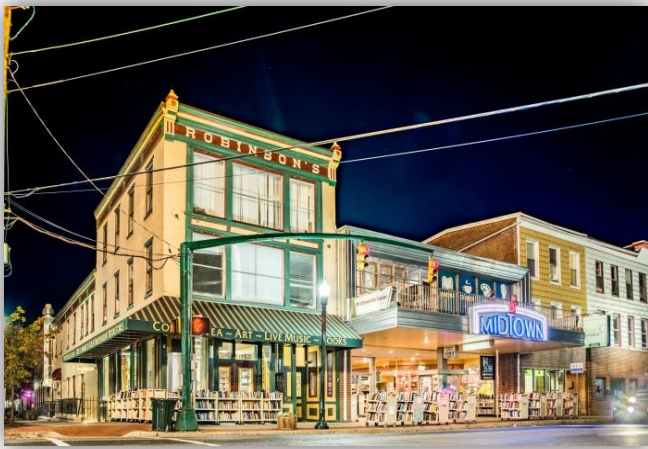

With over 15,000 square feet of space and over 200,000 new and used books, the Midtown Scholar Bookstore is a venue capable of hosting large, successful author events in the heart of Pennsylvania’s capital. **The bookstore is located less than a mile from the Harrisburg Train Station and is a quick ten minute drive to the Harrisburg International Airport** – making the store an easy thoroughfare between major East Coast cities.

We have been voted Simply the Best Independent Bookstore by Harrisburg Magazine every year since 2004, and we have strong relationships with local community groups and media, including a **Pick of the Month Partnership with WITF, Central Pennsylvania’s NPR & PBS affiliate.**

We are a New York Times and American Bookseller Association reporting store, and we will be hosting the 2017 Harrisburg Book Festival this October, which will likely be the **largest book festival in Pennsylvania.**
