### Composition

- Committee members should be strategic thinkers who are knowledgeable about various facets of the legal industry.
- Committee members should be members of or have access to other legal associations, legal vendors, educators, or other sources to gain a broad understanding of changes occurring or possible in the legal industry.

### Benefits

Members of the Foresight & Innovation Committee will expand their professional networks with NALS members, be up to date on current issues in the legal field, and influence the future of the Association.

### Committee Responsibilities & Tasks

- Scan publications, social media, etc. of organizations throughout the legal industry (e.g., ABA, ALA, NALA, AAFPE, etc.).
- Stay abreast of new developments from vendors within to the legal field.
- Review new or changing regulations, with an eye for trends across multiple states.
- Report to the NALS Board twice per year on trends, changes, etc. that could impact the future of the legal support field or the Association.
