Policy resolutions are critical in defining the advocacy agenda and positions of NAPABA.

2 WAYS TO SUBMIT A RESOLUTION



NEW

- May raise new topics – can replace or repeal an existing resolution
- Must include supporting documentation:
 - Summary of resolution's purpose
 - Backgrounders: supporting facts, cases, scenarios, statistics
 - Explanation of NAPABA's interest and position taken

UPDATE

- May update or amend to reflect changes in:
 - Statistics
 - Data references
 - Legislation
 - Other information
- Updating statistics and legislation: only needs a footnote citation
- Substantive change: needs supporting documentation
- Must be submitted in redline form

PROCESS

Committees submit proposed/updated resolutions to staff

Full NAPABA Board meets to discuss and vote on resolutions, setting them as NAPABA policy until repealed

Committees draft or update policy resolutions for the upcoming year

Staff and Board review policy resolutions
