



Dr. Katy Wynne has been with the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control's Tobacco Control Program for almost 18 years and has managed the statewide Tobacco Quitline since its beginning in August 2006. Over her 18 years, she has provided leadership in population health efforts to promote tobacco cessation among high risk groups – managing a \$35 million SC Tobacco Quitline contract; providing policy development and training expertise to public health regions across the state and other partners; promoting health systems change with multiple health care systems, providers, and organizations; and interpreting federal, state, and local policies that impact long-term public health chronic disease outcomes. Dr. Wynne's experience also includes dealing with sustainability challenges and developing and employing approaches and strategies to face such challenges. In addition, she is the state tobacco cessation policy coordinator and currently serves as a member of the Advisory Committee for the North American Quitline Consortium. Along with these responsibilities, Dr. Wynne also teaches policy and leadership graduate courses in the College of Social Work at the University of South Carolina and at Columbia College in Columbia, SC. Dr. Wynne holds a doctorate in Health Education Administration and a Masters in Social Work, both from the University of South Carolina. She is also an alumnus of Columbia College, where she earned her Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology.
