Michael McDuff was appointed by Governor Jindal in 2008 to serve as the Executive Director of the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors. Since 1985, Michael has worked in various positions with the construction industry in Louisiana. From 1997-2004, he served as the Director of Business Development with Petrin Corporation in the field of industrial construction doing work in the Southeastern Region of the U.S. From 2004-2008, Michael was the Executive Director of the Baton Rouge Growth Coalition that was comprised of architects, builders, engineers, and real estate developers facing governmental ordinances and regulations while promoting the principles of Smart Growth for the civic community.
