RE: 7th Annual ETS Symposium at NASDTEC
Wednesday, June 5, 2019

After the NASDTEC Annual Conference, it has become our tradition to host a half-day symposium. Lillian Lowery, ETS's new Vice President of Student & Teacher Assessment, will be leading a discussion on **How Is Teacher Licensure Evolving — and How Does it Need to Evolve — to Meet States' Changing Needs?**

The centerpiece of this half-day event, will be the discussion, facilitated by Lowery about change in licensure. We welcome you to join that discussion, which will be informed by updates on changes to how teaching competencies are being assessed including (1) a look at assessments — both in the field and in program development — that integrate content assessment with instructional practice, and (2) a look at the state of micro-credentialing, including where and how it is being used to support and measure development of critical competencies teachers need for their jobs and schools.

All costs will be covered, including your Tuesday night accommodations, breakfast and lunch during the symposium, and transportation to the airport. Flight departure should be scheduled for after 2:30 p.m.
