The National Association of Social Workers South Dakota Chapter (NASW-SD) invites you to participate in our statewide conference through the submission of abstracts for consideration for presentation. In addition to the 60 minute break out sessions, you may also submit for a longer 75 minute options for more in depth subjects

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

- CEU programs must be at least 60 or 75 minutes in duration.
- The program's objectives must relate to the practice of mental health and/or macro practice.
- Programs must be open to all mental health practitioners licensed by South Dakota who meet the training and educational pre-requisites for the program.
- Presenters of programs must be qualified by education, experience or training.
- Employment cannot be considered as a pre-requisite.
- All professions will be considered equally.
- Presentations focused on a specific product or advertisement will not be considered.

Break-out Sessions:

- Break-out sessions are 60 or 75 minutes in length.
- Abstracts must have a title, a minimum of 3 learning objectives and/or research references.
- Selected proposals will receive a 25% discount on registration for the entire conference.
- You may attend only your presentation without a registration.

Selection Process

Proposals will be reviewed based on the following criteria:

1. The abstract is well organized, concise, and clearly written.
2. The author clearly states the purpose and objectives of the presentation.
3. The proposal provides evidence of the author's knowledge of the topic.
4. The subject contributes to a balanced conference program.

Audiovisual equipment: NASW-SD will only provide a LCD Projector and screen. You will need to provide all other AV equipment, **including a laptop**. It will also be your responsibility to provide all handouts for the presentation. **If you are a Mac user it is your responsibility to provide the connection cable to the LCD Projector.**

All Proposals Must Be Submitted Electronically

You will be asked for the following information:

- Name(s), address, email, phone #s and a brief bio
- Co-Presenter name and brief bio (if applicable)
- Track which best fits the proposal
 - Admin/macro social work
 - Clinical (targeted for clinicians)
 - Direct practice (for all social workers)
 - Social Justice (social policy related)
- Presentation Information as follows:
