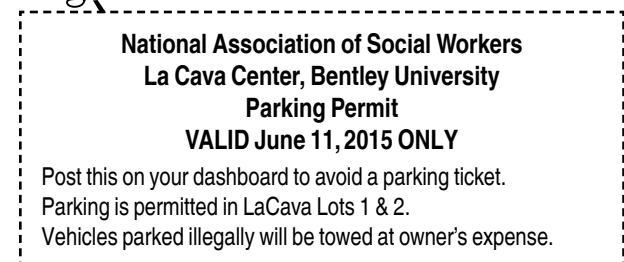

From Points North

- Take Rte. 95/128 South to Trapelo Rd., exit 28
- Turn left at top of exit ramp
- Follow Trapelo Rd. 2.6 miles toward Belmont
- Turn right onto Forest St.
- Proceed on Forest St. for .9 miles, main entrance on left

From Points South

- Take Rte. 95/128 North to Totten Pond Rd., Exit 27A
- At the end of the ramp, take a right and follow Totten Pond Rd. for 1.2 miles to the end
- Take a right onto Lexington St. and go .2 miles
- Then take a left onto Beaver St.; travel 1 mile (go around the rotary and continue on) and take a left onto Forest St.
- The main entrance is about .3 miles on your right

From Points East/Boston

- Follow Storrow Drive (west) or Memorial Drive (west) to the end and follow signs toward Arlington
- Bear left at the sign that reads "To 16 S Watertown/Waltham"
- Follow for .6 miles and turn right onto Belmont St. after passing the Star Market shopping center on the right
- Continue on Belmont St. until it intersects with Trapelo Rd.
- Bear right onto Trapelo Rd. and continue for 1.7 miles
- Take a left at the light and follow the sign that reads "60 Waltham to Rte. 20"; This is Waverley Oaks Rd. (Rte. 60)
- At the next traffic light, turn right onto Beaver St.
- Continue on Beaver St. past the tennis courts for .9 miles to Forest St.
- Turn right onto Forest St.; main entrance is .3 miles on right

From Points West

- Take exit 14 off the Massachusetts Turnpike
- Follow signs to Rte. 95/128 North
- Take Rte. 95/128 North to Trapelo Rd., exit 28A
- Turn right at the end of the exit ramp
- Follow 2.6 miles toward Belmont
- Turn right onto Forest St.
- Proceed on Forest St. for .9 miles; main entrance on left
