Article Submission Guidelines

Submission should be sent to ContactUs@naswnyc.org, please state clearly in the Subject Line which issue you are submitting for. Please read the entire guidelines before submitting.

Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

1. Format

a. Cover Page

- i. Clearly indicate authors Name and Credentials.
- ii. Clearly indicate Title of the work.
- iii. Please include a brief 10-15 word synopsis of the article.

b. Article

- i. No more than one single spaced page, between 10 and 12 point font.
- ii. Must be submitted by stated deadline for consideration.
- iii. Well written, with limited errors.

2. Content

- a. Micro, Mezzo, and Macro perspectives welcome.
- b. Authors are encouraged to share lived experience and provable expertise. We may request a copy of your CV/Resume.
- c. No direct stories or names of clients can be used, in any form.
- d. Generalizations from Client experience are acceptable.

- a. Submission does not guarantee publication.
- b. Articles will be retained for consideration of future issues; we will seek authorial approval before submission.
- c. We reserve the right to edit articles for grammar, length, and content. We will never add content.
