This includes toileting, feeding, showering, dressing, and maintaining health and hygiene.

Full Time, Part Time and Weekend positions Several Shift are currently available for individuals with flexible schedules for days, evenings and overnights; weekdays and weekends.

Responsibilities:

- The respectful engagement of people with developmental disabilities.
- Maintaining accurate logs of daily activities including but not limited to: medication administration, vehicle log books, daily activities, fire drill logs etc.
- Working as a team with other DCW's to provide a safe and stable space for our clients to stay in.
- Bringing our clients into the community to engage in numerous activities and to help teach daily living skills.
- Maintaining the order and cleanliness of the group home (including doing laundry, sweeping, mopping, dusting, surfaces).
- Live through the values at Sheltering Arms to ensure that we are transforming the lives and communities of New Yorkers in need.
