Agency Description: STEPS To End Family Violence (STEPS) offers a variety of innovative, trauma-informed, anti-oppressive programming focused on the prevention of intimate partner violence; advocacy and healing for survivors; as well as increasing awareness of the epidemic of gender-based violence; and transforming the rhetoric and institutions that sustain such violence.

Location and Position Summary: The GRL Senior Counselor will provide individual counseling, group counseling and educational services for female identified people, between the ages of 13 and 24 years who have or have had any type of involvement in the child welfare system. The position is based at our East Harlem location (4 days/week) and at the Manhattan Family Justice Center (once per week).

Core Responsibilities:

- Provide therapeutic trauma-informed individual, and crisis counseling
- Design, implement, and facilitate supportive, educational, group counseling
- Maintain accurate case files
- Participate actively in weekly individual and team supervision
- Complete related paperwork in a timely manner

Qualifications:

- Master's degree in social work or related field
- LMSW or LMHC REQUIRED
- Minimum of two years of counseling experience preferred
- Knowledge and understanding of adolescent development, and trauma
- Proficiency working with individuals from diverse backgrounds and lifestyles
- Passion for incorporating reflective practice around issues of race, oppression, and diversity into clinical work
- Exceptional interpersonal, speaking, and writing skills and the ability to apply these skills in diverse situations
- Demonstrated ability to be flexible and work as a team member, and independently
