**Social Worker Job Opening at Columbia University Medical Center: Columbia University Clinic for Anxiety and Related Disorders – Westchester**

**Position Titles:** Associate in Clinical/Instructor/Assistant Professor level positions in the Department of Psychiatry at Columbia University Medical Center (CUMC)

**Job Description:**

The Department of Psychiatry is seeking full-time LCSW clinicians to work in a new intensive day treatment program at the Columbia University Clinic for Anxiety and Related Disorders (CUCARD) Westchester in Tarrytown, NY. Primary responsibilities involve conducting individual and group therapy utilizing empirically supported treatments, diagnostic/intake evaluations of children and adolescents, and individual treatment planning and progress monitoring with patients. Clinicians will be expected to maintain regular contact with patients' outside providers and facilitate appropriate discharge to outpatient care when needed. Candidates must have substantial experience working with children and adolescents with anxiety disorders and with cognitive behavioral therapy. Experience working with high-risk patients is preferred. Applicants should have strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work well across disciplines and function effectively as part of a multi-disciplinary team.

1. Candidate(s) will conduct intake evaluations/diagnostic assessments of child and adolescent patients.
2. Candidate(s) will provide individual and group psychotherapy and will coordinate discharge plans for patients.
3. Candidate(s) will work closely with a clinical team, including psychologists, social workers, and psychiatrists.
4. Candidate(s) will have opportunities to attend case conferences, peer supervision and Grand Rounds at CUMC. Opportunities may exist for clinical supervision and teaching.
