Delivers mental health treatment services in New Alternatives for Children's Article 31 Mental Health Clinic Program. Provides individual, collateral, family, and/or group psychotherapy, intake and assessment, and crisis intervention services. Clinic primarily serves children and families involved in the child welfare system. Completes required documentation within prescribed timeframes. Clinical supervision provided.

Description of Responsibilities:

- Provides individual, collateral and/or group psychotherapy sessions to clients in NAC's Mental Health Clinic;
- Completes intake evaluations;
- Documents sessions by means of progress notes;
- Completes required documentation including treatment plans and quarterly treatment plan reviews;
- Assigned clients, but makes own appointments;
- Works with the NAC multidisciplinary team, the client's family, and other service providers as appropriate, to meet treatment goals and assure continuity of care; and
- Performs all duties in accordance with New York State Office of Mental Health and federal regulations, as well as NAC's Mental Health Clinic Treatment Program Policy & Procedures Manual.

- Licensed Master Social Worker, Licensed Clinical Social Worker, Licensed Mental Health Counselor, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists or Licensed Psychologist
