

TF-CBT Per Diem Social Worker/Counselor – Spanish Speaking

The Family Center Mental Health Clinic is expanding provision of trauma-focused mental health services to unaccompanied minors (minors separated from parents/guardians at the border and who are now residing with or without family members in NYC). Social Worker/Mental Health Counselor must be familiar with TF-CBT and/or other trauma-informed interventions for children. Services will be provided in TFC's Brooklyn office and in clients' homes throughout NYC. Hours of service will be mid-afternoon to early evening (ie.2 pm-7 pm), with flexibility to specific days during the week.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide TF-CBT and other trauma-informed therapeutic counseling interventions for unaccompanied children and adolescents and their parents/caregivers.
- Conduct thorough assessments and develop quarterly treatment plans.
- Assist clients in obtaining additional medical and other services, as needed.
- Facilitate groups designed to meet the needs of children and teens impacted by trauma and their parents/caregivers.
- Monitor client's treatment and comply with all required documentation in a timely manner.
- Work with other members of multidisciplinary team to ensure families are connected to needed services provided through partner CBOs and government agencies, including Department of Education, ACS etc.
- Ensure continuity of services for clients and families; collaborate with other social service agencies to provide wraparound services for clients and their families.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Licensed LMSW, LCSW, LMHC or LMFT by the state of New York
- Bilingual Spanish; experienced in conducting therapeutic interventions in Spanish
- Familiarity with trauma-informed interventions for children and teens including TF-CBT
- Experience providing home based services a plus
- Thorough understanding of DSM-V mental health diagnoses and treatment approaches for children and teens.
- Excellent writing skills and ability to meet all NYS OMH documentation expectations and submission deadlines.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with clinical team members including other therapists, psychiatrist, and supervisors.
- Demonstrated computer proficiency (Microsoft word), including familiarity with electronic documentation programs.
- Demonstrated ability to work efficiently and effectively in a high-paced, professional environment.
