Established in 1915, the cabin program is one of the oldest public recreation programs on our National Forests. In a unique public-private partnership, permittees own these cabins in the woods for seasonal use, but the ground beneath is public land and still part of the National Forests. Throughout its long and colorful history, the Recreational Residence Program has provided generations of Americans with inspirational outdoor experiences and instilled a deep connection to the land.

Nearly 14,000 cabin owners across the country enjoy the outdoor life on our public lands and are stakeholders in our National Forests. With over 100 years of heritage and a strong commitment to forest stewardship, we are devoted to a future that includes recreation residence cabins.
