Cheryl LaFleur, Chairman
Federal Energy Regulatory Commission



Chairman Cheryl A. LaFleur was first nominated by President Barack Obama to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in 2010 and was confirmed for a second term by the Senate in 2014. She was named Acting Chairman on November 25, 2013 and Chairman on July 30, 2014. Chairman LaFleur, has more than 25 years experience in the electric and natural gas industry and has been an active leader in the growth of energy efficiency, the introduction of competitive energy markets, the development of strategies for environmental improvement, and efforts to strengthen reliability and safety. She has been a frequent public speaker on energy, environmental and management issues. Prior to joining the FERC, Chairman LaFleur served as Executive Vice President and acting CEO of National Grid USA and as chief operating officer and general counsel at National Grid's predecessor, New England Electric System. She helped lead the company through several regulatory and corporate transformations including the deregulation of energy supply, the transition to performance-based ratemaking, and several mergers. Earlier in her career, she was responsible for leading award-winning conservation and demand response programs for customers. Chairman LaFleur is a native of Massachusetts.

Phil Giudice is the CEO of Ambri. Ambri, formerly Liquid Metal Battery Corporation, a technology company creating cost effective, reliable, widespread grid electricity storage solutions, enabling separation of power demand from power supply. In addition, Mr. Giudice is a board member for the energy business leadership trade group Advanced Energy Economy as well as the efficiency start up FirstFuel. Mr. Giudice has more than 30 years' experience in the energy industry as a geologist, consultant, executive, and state official with a focus on delivering innovative solutions to the energy industry. He previously served as Massachusetts Undersecretary of Energy and as Commissioner of the Department of Energy Resources, the state agency with primary responsibility for fulfilling Governor Deval Patrick's vision for a clean energy future. Prior to that, Mr. Giudice was a senior vice president and board member at EnerNOC, a start-up providing electricity demand-management services to businesses, institutions, utilities, and grid operators that became a public company in 2007.
