Cold Turkey: Can New England quit fossil fuels?

New England towns are passing natural gas bans; the states are subsidizing investments in clean energy; the MA Attorney General wants to investigate the future of natural gas; and FERC is considering carbon pricing in wholesale electricity markets. Meanwhile utilities are banned from shutting customers off due to the pandemic; ISO-NE is addressing energy security initiatives; natural gas powered more than 65% of New England's electricity this summer; and demand for natural gas services is robust. 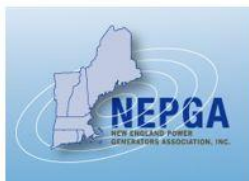
