Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final Class (new in 2018)				

Eight large (standard) sand arenas for all classes, altered to small arena for Para Equestrian Grades that require small arena. Tentative Schedule of Classes is now posted on NEDA website; it will be updated after classes are scheduled in late August.

- (1) Not FEI Recognized; FEI Saddlery Rules apply. Passport not required. No jog. On Thursday USEF FEI classes will be completed prior to the FEI Jog. Only latest versions of FEI tests may be ridden. No freestyles or para equestrian tests. Specify test clearly on Entry Form. FEI Pony tests must be ridden by a junior (12 – 16). Ponies will not be measured. Entries to any FEI Young Horse tests will be scored and pinned separately as another class. If Stakes Class 151 is divided, prize monies will also be divided equally. Classes 251, 351 and 451 will be divided by test if entries warrant.
- (2) Not FEI Recognized. FEI Rules for Para Equestrians apply. Latest versions of FEI tests will be used. Passport not required. No jog. Submit Para Equestrian documentation with Entry. All tests will be held in large arena, as much as FEI rules allow; small arena will be used only when there is no FEI option to use a large arena. Classes 261 and 461 are non freestyle tests; class 361 is freestyle test only.
- (3) Qualifying class for 2019 Great American Insurance Group / United States Dressage Federation Regional Dressage Championships. Include \$15 (beyond entry fee) to have ride score reported. Only classes so specified may be used as qualifiers.
- (4) Current FEI Young Rider Grand Prix 16-25 Test. For Young Adults: riders are eligible from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 20 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 28.
- (5) Current FEI Pony Team and Individual Tests. Riders aged 12-16 per USEF DR119.8.
- (6) FEI Intermediate A and FEI Intermediate B tests may not be ridden as qualifying for the Great American Insurance Group / United States Dressage Federation Regional Championships.
- (7) Training Level Freestyle tests may not be ridden as qualifying for the Great American Insurance Group / United States Dressage Federation Regional Championships.
- (8) Athletes are eligible as Children from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 14. Athletes may compete on either a horse or pony.
- (9) To compete in the USDF Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final class, riders must have qualified by obtaining a 70% or higher in an applicable equitation class during the qualifying period OR be qualified for the Great American/USDF Regional Championships at any level except freestyle. Additional requirements may be found on USDF.org or by contacting the USDF office. Please note: class entry fee includes \$35 per rider show must pay to USDF.

**JUNIOR / YOUNG RIDER DIVISION AWARDS
ADULT AMATEUR DIVISION AWARDS**

Separate ribbons to six places, in addition to regular ribbons, for each Division (Junior/Young Rider Division and Adult Amateur Division) given in every class. Specify Jr/YR Division (per USEF GR115/120) or Adult Amateur Division (per USEF GR808) on Entry Form. USEF Adult Amateur membership and copy of current membership card required for Adult Amateur Division; USEF membership is not required for Jr/YR Division. NEDA membership not required. Jr/YR and Adult Amateurs will be designated in show program.

JUNIOR / YOUNG RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP
ADULT AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP**

Specify Jr/YR Division (per USEF DR115/120 of USEF rules) or Adult Amateur Division (per USEF DR808 of USEF rules) on Entry Form. USEF Adult Amateur membership and copy of current membership card required for Adult Amateur Division; USEF membership is not required for Jr/YR Division. NEDA membership not required. Jr/YR and Adult Amateurs will be designated in show program. Any protest concerning an entrant's eligibility to Jr/YR or Adult Amateur Division must be filed in writing, with signature, at Headquarters by noon on Saturday. Show management will make final decision as to an entrant's eligibility. Competitors may enter both Sweepstakes and either of these Championships.

Competitor need not apply for Jr/YR of Adult Amateur Championship. For all Jr/YR and Adult Amateur competitors, all rides actually ridden on Thursday, Friday, and / or Saturday will be eligible. No Freestyle (or other musical rides) or FEI Young Horse scores will be considered. No Breed Show scores will be considered. Otherwise, all rides from CDI, Regional Championships, and Open Dressage Show will be considered.

Winners will be selected using only the highest percentage score of each rider regardless of horse. Scores from each eligible ride will be ranked in order. Only the highest score per rider will be considered; a rider can place only once. In case of tie, the higher level test will take precedence. Six highest scoring riders in each Division will receive championship ribbon and cash award: 1st \$400 / 2nd \$300 / 3rd \$200 / 4th \$100 / 5th \$50 / 6th \$25. Awards will be mailed to Owner on Entry Form (be sure address is valid!) if winners are not present to pick them up.



UNITED STATES DRESSAGE FEDERATION™
Regional Adult Amateur Equitation Program

The USDF Regional Adult Amateur Equitation Program recognizes adult amateurs competing in equitation and promotes correct seat, position, and use of the aids in dressage. An Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final class will be held in conjunction with each of the nine USDF Regional Dressage Championship competitions, providing adult amateurs with additional opportunity for recognition.

Adult amateurs wishing to qualify to compete in an Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final may do so by meeting the following requirements.

Qualifying Requirements

To be eligible for the USDF Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final class, rider must have

- a) Earned a score of 70% or higher in any dressage seat equitation class (except walk/trot) at a USEF/USDF-recognized Dressage competition within the qualifying period of the applicable regional championship.

or

- b) Qualified to compete in any regional dressage championship class (excluding freestyles).

Membership Requirements

- Rider must have a USDF Participating Membership at the time the qualifying score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.
- Rider must be an adult amateur, in accordance with GR1306 of the USEF rules, and be designated with USEF as an adult amateur when the score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.
- Owner must have a USDF Participating or Business Membership when the qualifying score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.
- Horse must have a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration when the qualifying score is earned, and at the time of the Regional Final class.
