21. Produce of Dam - 2 or 3 offspring w/wo dam
22. Get of Sire - without sire, 2 or 3 of get
23. Breeder's Group - Group of two or three horses of any age or sex, all bred by the same exhibitor, and all must have shown in one in-hand class.

Amateur & JrYR Handler – To be shown in-hand by an Amateur or Jr/YR with a current USEF Amateur card. Open to fillies/mares and geldings in any age group. No Stallions or colts except weanlings. To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of the handler, overall condition of the animal, handling techniques, appropriate tack and equipment, demonstration of correct training and ability to show horse to the best of its ability.

24. Amateur Handler - Class will be divided as JR and AA if entries warrant.

Materiale Classes – Horses will be judged according to the criteria listed on the “USDF Materiale Score Sheet. Ages maybe combined (Fillies/Mares or Colts/Geldings/Stallions) if entries warrant.

- 25. Fillies - 3 year old
- 26. Colts/Geldings - 3 year old
- 27. Mares - 4 & 5 year old
- 28. Stallions/Geldings - 4 & 5 year old

Under Saddle Classes – For classes 29 thru 34, entries shall be shown at the walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judging to be weighted 60% Movement, 30% Confirmation, 10% General impression.

- 29. Fillies - 3 years old
- 30. Colts/Geldings - 3 years old
- 31. Mares - 4 year & older
- 32. Stallion/Gelding - 4 year & older
- 33. Suitable to become a Dressage Horse - Entries must be at least 36 mos and no more than 7 years old, and cannot have competed above First Level.
- 34. Under Saddle Championship - open to 1st and 2nd place from 29 thru 33.

Individual Breed Classes- Complete breed registration documentation must accompany entry. IBC classes will be held both Saturday & Sunday

New England Breed Show Series Sweepstakes and \$2100 NEDA Fall Show Purse

Entry into the New England Breed Show Series Sweepstakes is \$50/horse at this qualifying breed show. The scores from the primary in hand classes (foal, yearling, 2 year old, 3 year old, mares and stallions) at this show will count towards the cash award at this show. Only 1 score per show per horse qualifies. Entry fee must be in before the start of the show. Minimum award for 1st place at this show is \$50 and will depend upon entries. If there is less than 6 entries, only the number of entries will be awarded.

Each horse that enters and competes at at least one qualifying breed show will automatically qualify for the NEDA Fall Breed Show Sweepstakes for free. No Sweepstakes fee is charged at the NEDA Fall Breed Show, but the class entry fee is still required. The qualifying horse must enter and compete in the NEDA Fall Breed Show priary age group class (foal, yearling, 2 year old, 3 year old, mares and stallions) to receive the Sweepstakes prize for the NEDA Fall Breed Show. NEDA will provide a cash award to the top 6 “colts” and top 6 “fillies” at the NEDA Fall Show. 1st place \$300, 2nd \$250, 3rd \$200, 4th \$150, 5th \$100, 6th \$50.
